The undersigned states that there exists probable cause to believe that the following person, property or thing(s) to be searched for, and if found, seized will be found on the aforementioned person(s) and or premises and are described as follows:

The following affidavit is made in support of a request for the issuance of a search warrant to search: [REDACTED] which is located in the City of Englewood, in Arapahoe County, in the State of Colorado. The address is a single family residence, tri-level structure, with red brick on its lower portion, and white stucco on the upper portion, with blue trim, an attached two car garage. The numbers [REDACTED] are black on a white background, left of the residence front door, at eye level. The house is situated on the north side of the street.

Your affiant is Detective Bradley Pratt 2422. Your affiant is a Sworn Police Officer for the Colorado Springs Police Department, and is currently assigned as a Violent Crimes Homicide Detective.

One of your Affiant's duties is investigating homicides and serious assaults occurring in the City of Colorado Springs. Your Affiant has personal knowledge of the following facts, which have been documented in official Colorado Springs Police Department offense report 07-40399, titled Murder in the First Degree (18-3-102).

On 12/09/2007 the Colorado Springs Police Department was dispatched to 11035 Voyager Parkway, an address known as 'New Life Church', which is located in the City of Colorado Springs, in El Paso County, in the State of Colorado. Police Officer's responded to this address, for reports of shots fired.

It was reported that an active gunman was inside the church, shooting at people. During the on-scene follow-up investigation, it was determined that the suspect, Matthew Murray, DOB 12/05/1983, arrived at the church, and once in the parking lot, began firing a weapon at victims in the parking lot. The suspect then entered the foyer area of the church, and continued firing at suspects inside. The suspect was engaged by an armed security guard, inside the church, and was ultimately shot and killed by the security guard. Your affiant would note there were a total of five shooting victims, one of which is deceased. It appears as if the suspect could have deployed distraction devices, possibly in the form of homemade smoke grenades, and / or improvised explosive devices (IED's), while in the parking lot, prior to the occurrence.

Your affiant would further note that on 12/09/2007, at approximately 0030 hours, the Arvada Police Department responded to 12750 W. 63rd avenue, which is located in Arvada Colorado, reference a double homicide. Their investigation revealed that a suspect entered this address, and shot four individuals, two of which are deceased. Through both investigations, it has been determined that most likely the suspect in both shootings are one in the same. The common denominator with both locations of occurrence, is a church based group called 'Youth With A Mission' (Y-WAM). It appears that the suspect had been kicked out of the program approximately three years prior, and during the past few weeks, had sent different forms of hate mail to the program, and / or its director.

Working with Detectives from the Arvada Police Department, your affiant learned that the suspect lived at [REDACTED], which is located in the City of Englewood, in Arapahoe County, in the State of Colorado. The address is a single family residence, tri-level structure, with red brick on its lower portion, and white stucco on the upper portion, with blue trim, an attached two car garage. The numbers [REDACTED] are black on a white background, left of the residence front door, at eye level. The house is situated on the north side of the street.

Your affiant learned that inside the residence, the suspect owns a computer, which he used to attend a home based computer school. The suspect has reportedly worked on this desk top computer for
