

Date killer arrested	11/17/1980
Date convicted	June 21, 1983-sentenced to death in a California courtroom for the murders of Mary Beth Sowers and Craig Miller. May 23, 1984-sentenced to death for the killings of Karen Twiggs & Stacey Redican in Nevada (making him one of the few people to ever be sentenced to death simultaneously in two states); death sentence for Nevada was overturned in 1997 and there was a court ordered retrial of the penalty phase. There was also a large, nationwide outpouring against Mr. Gallego and the prosecution in Nevada was partly financed by the public. The small town of Lovelock, Nevada was afraid that the budget could not afford to prosecute the killer, so the public sent in from \$19,000- \$25,000 in donations to help fund the case.
